NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, March 15, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, 385 North Arrowhead Avenue, First Floor, San Bernardino, CA. The purpose of the hearing is to consider the proposed substantial amendment to the 2020-2025 United States Housing and Urban Development Consolidated Plan and 2021-2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan as it pertains to the County's CDBG program and to solicit citizen comments regarding the proposed substantial plan amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Each year since 1975, the County of San Bernardino has qualified to receive federal housing and community development grant funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the form of CDBG funds. These funds are to develop viable communities by providing decent housing, suitable living environments and expanded economic opportunities, principally for low- and moderate-income persons.

ADDITIONAL SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT PROVISION:

Items may be added or deleted from the Proposed Substantial Amendment at the Board of Supervisors hearing.

CITIZEN REVIEW AND COMMENTS:

The substantial amendment will be available for public review and comment during a thirty (30) day period from January 28, 2022 through March 15, 2022, at the County's Community Development and Housing Department, address listed below. Those individuals wishing to express their views on this proposed substantial amendment may be present and heard at the Board of Supervisors meeting or may, prior to the time of the Board meeting, submit comments in writing to CDH.

If you challenge any decision regarding the above proposal in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Board meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the Board hearing.
